



Lions from clubs in good standing can enter an original, unaltered, black-and-white or color photo of the environment of their Lions club in the 2007-08 Lions Environmental Photo Contest. Photos cannot include people. Lion photographers accept responsibility for the cost of taking and processing all photos. The five photo categories are:

- Animal Life
- Landscape (Urban or natural)
- Plant Life
- Weather Phenomenon
- *Our Changing Environment* (the 2007-08 special theme)

The impartial judging of photos at all four levels of the contest should focus on originality, artistic merit, and portrayal of the environmental theme.

- LIONS CLUBS select and submit one winning photo to the district.
- LIONS DISTRICTS select and submit one winning photo to the multiple district. **January 15, 2008** is the suggested deadline for districts to submit one 8" x 10" (20.3 x 25.4 cm) printed photo to the multiple district.
- LIONS MULTIPLE DISTRICTS select and submit one winning photo to the international contest. **March 15, 2008** is the deadline for multiple districts to submit one 8" x 10" (20.3 x 25.4 cm) printed photograph and an official entry form (available on the Lions Web site) signed by the council chairperson to Lions International Headquarters.
- LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL will display multiple district-level entries at the annual Lions international convention. Registered convention attendees will vote for their favorite photos. An award will be presented to the winning photographers. The six (the five category winners and the Best of Show) winning photos will appear on the Lions Web site and in the headquarters edition of THE LION Magazine.

Contest photos become the property of Lions Clubs International.
