3. THERE HAS BEEN GOOD SOCIAL CONTACT BETWEEN CLUBS, MALVERN HILLS AND WORCESTER HELD A JOINT SOCIAL EVENT AND A JOINT FUND RAISING CAN SHAKE.
4. I HAVE VISITED MALVERN AND DROITWICH AND ARRANGEMENTS ARE IN HAND TO VISIT BROMSGROVE AND KIDDERMINSTER AT THEIR NEXT BUSINESS MEETING, AND THIS WILL COMPLETE MY CLUB VISITS.
5.
