I also visited a preschool nursery and an orphanage. I was very impressed how the Hikkaduwa Lions, a club of 29 members had managed to secure International funding from Clubs in Sweden and Germany as well as the UK to finance so many projects. Other things which they offer are loans to medical students, micro loans to those in need and providing a fostering service. There are still funding needs for instance, the changing rooms at the Swimming Pool do not have any lockers or hooks just a table in the corner. My overall impression was how wisely the money had been spent and the benefit that the local community was getting from all these projects.
