Since July 07, we have distributed 42 boxes, which equates to some 9,000 bottles

In addition Solihull PCT have taken some 90 boxes (19,000 bottles) of which 17,000 have been distributed with some Lions Clubs in the area more active than others.

BEN PCT area have over 60,000 bottles distributed to people over 65, but not to people who are in need but are much younger; requests from them for bottles are being referred to local Lions Clubs where appropriate.

News about the bottles is spreading as a result of publicity in above areas and requests for more Miab are communicated to local Lions Clubs.

Generally, requests for bottles form Lions Clubs in the District seem to have slowed down, compared to the previous year, particularly for the Clubs outside the Solihull PCT area.

OBJECTIVES

To promote the Lions Message in a Bottle Scheme to all the Clubs and other organisations in the district. I hope to continue to attend Zone meetings to encourage more Clubs to participate in MiaB.
